

is that the Defendants is deemed to have admitted all the facts and claims as stated by the Claimant in this case, the law is trite that facts admitted need no further proof, see **Section 123 Evidence (Amendment) Act, 2023** and the case of **CBN V. DINNEH (2010) 17 NWLR (PT. 1221) PAGE 125, 162 at paragraphs C-D.**

I have carefully considered the evidence adduced by the claimant in this case, the documents relied on, I have also considered all the prayers as sought by the claimant and which for the sake of emphasis I must repeat are unchallenged by the Defendant and I find that the claim of the claimant has merit, same succeeds and it is hereby adjudged as follows, that the claimant is entitled to :

1. The sum of ₦21,000,500 (Twenty One Thousand Five Hundred Naira) only being and representing money paid to the defendant for issuance of drivers licence for the claimant
2. Court fee of ₦60,000,00 (Sixty Thousand Naira)
3. Cost of ₦68,000.00 (Sixty Eight Thousand Naira) only .

I make no further orders.
